

Sermon Questions

Hebrews 1:1-3

This week we took the time to pause and proclaim the supremacy of Jesus Christ. In the first three verses of Hebrews seven attributes of our Lord and Savior are listed. Each of these attributes are extremely powerful and exclusive. Just a casual reading of the book of Hebrews causes the reader to pause and understand that Jesus Christ is the premier prophet, priest and king. When understood properly the book continues to ask the reader, "How are you going to respond to the greatness of Jesus Christ?" Throughout our study we are going to see the greatness of Jesus Christ on display and will then be forced to respond to His greatness. This sermon series is going to be a great journey and if you seek the Lord and open your heart you will be in a deeper and more mature place with the Lord when this study is complete. So, let's get started and begin to understand the greatness of our God.

Questions

1. What does the word "G.O.A.T." mean? Who are some of the people that our world gives the title the "Greatest of All Time" to? Why? Why would Jesus Christ be considered the Greatest of All Time?
2. What is the role of a prophet? What is the role of a priest? What is the role of a king? How was and is Jesus the premier prophet, priest and king? If Jesus Christ is indeed the epitome of these roles, then how are we called to respond?
3. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Kingly Authority? What does it mean that Jesus Christ has Kingly Authority? What is an heir? What does it mean that He is the beneficiary of the universe? What does it mean that we are co-heirs with Christ? How much authority does Jesus Christ have? What is the scope of his authority?
4. How did Jesus Christ explain His authority to the high priest in Mark 14:62? How does Jesus Christ respond the question of "Who is worthy to take the scroll in Revelation 5?" Why is understanding the Lordship of Jesus Christ so important?
5. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Spoken Creation? When did Jesus Christ establish the universe? How did He do it? How powerful is Jesus if He can speak and establish everything? Who else can do this?
6. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Radiant Glory? Read John 1:1,14 & Revelation 1:12-17. How glorious is Jesus Christ? How does He manifest the glory of the Father? What does it mean that Jesus Christ is the light of the world? Who else besides Jesus Christ manifests God's glory?
7. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Perfect Image? How does the image of Jesus Christ differ from our image? Does Jesus Christ has to work on His image? What does it mean that He is the "exact representation" of the Father? How does Jesus Christ personify everything that is good (wisdom, knowledge, kindness, mercy, forgiveness, etc.)? What does it mean that in Jesus the full deity of God dwells (Colossians 2:9)?
8. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Powerful Word? How does the Word of God not only create but sustain? If Jesus Christ is holding everything together why are you anxious?
9. How is Jesus Christ the very embodiment of the Word (John 5:39-40)? Why is the Word so powerful (Psalm 19:7-11)? Why is it imperative that men of God preach the Word (2 Timothy 4:2)? What is more powerful that the Word of God? Why do so few people in our generation champion the Word?
10. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Sacrificial Atonement? How did Jesus Christ make purification of sins? Why was this important? Has anyone else ever atoned for sins? Read 1 John 4:10. How has God shown us love? What are other

verses that demonstrate that Jesus came to die for your sins? When did you receive forgiveness for your sins by confessing Jesus Christ as Lord?

11. How does the supremacy of Jesus Christ center on His Majestic Greatness? Why did Jesus Christ sit down? Why is His work still not completed? What is Jesus Christ currently doing? Why is He still worthy of all of our honor and praise? When is He coming back? Are you ready?
12. Which of these seven attributes stuck out the most to you this week? Why? How can you trust Jesus Christ more this week?
13. What was the greatest take away from the first three verses this week? What are you going to apply today to experience more of Jesus Christ?
