1. Comforts us that Jesus always delivers on His promises (16:28-17:3)

What promises from God's Word can your group collectively list?

Which of these are you holding on to by faith today?

How does the enemy try to undermine our faith in any of these promises?

2. Compels us to be ready for His return (4)

What do you think Peter was thinking when he spoke up (cf. Luke 9:33)?

How should this passage compel us to be ready for Christ's return?

What does it mean to be ready anyway? Are you ready for it?

3. Confirms to us the Deity of Christ (5-8)

What is the significance of clouds in the Scriptures? (see Ex 13:21; 40:34; Mark 14:62; Acts 1:9; Rev 1:7)

Why is the disciples' response to the Voice natural? (see Gen 3:8, 10; Isa 6:4-5; Ezek 1:28)

Why should the Father's confirmation of Christ's deity remove fear of dying from Christians?

4. Clarifies to us the Plan of God (9-13)

Why do you think Jesus told His disciples to tell no one about this until after His resurrection?

What is the significance of their question about Elijah?

What aspects of the plan of God are mentioned in the passage?

What will it look like for each of us to be devoted to assisting Him in His plan?
